

NT JMO Forum Report to NTPMC

February 2010

1. The first Forum Teleconference for 2010 was held on 10th February with representatives present from ASH and RDH. Issues from the 2009 report were covered and there has been lots of progress. Several new and ongoing issues were discussed:
 - The need for inclusion of PGY2+ in feedback/monitoring process
 - Junior doctors as members of the accreditation team – how and who?
 - Need for accurate information regarding inpatient workload to be provided from the hospitals to PMC
 - Need for further clarity on newly-created intern and PGY2 roles at RDH
 - ALS and Neonatal resuscitation training being established at RDH; in place at ASH
 - New Territory-wide education plan a welcome addition
 - New Education Sub-Committee in RMO Society at RDH
 - Regular meetings between JMOs and the DMS at RDH
 - **KDH: ongoing issues** with workload, training, supervision. Need for focus on Registrar rotations and improving all of these issues a priority
 - IMG subcommittee in place at RDH headed by Dr Clara Marin; await further direction
 - Plan for Face-to-Face to be held in Darwin on ?17-18th April; funding from the PMC to be sought
 - Quarterly Teleconferences to continue
